Ruth Greer, Ph.D. and John Turtz, Ph.D., Co-Directors of the Westchester Center for the Study of Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy, will be presenting on the fundamental principles of couples therapy. They will provide a brief overview of the basic tenets of systems theory along with how to integrate systems theory with psychoanalytic thinking. They will then move into a more clinical focus, examining the role of diagnosis in couples treatment and how to become more cognizant of various attachment styles. Other clinical issues to be explored are transference and countertransference in the context of couples therapy, boundary issues, projective identification, family of origin issues, the impact of children, and various clinical interventions.
