DESCRIPTION

In this presentation Ruth Greer and John Turtz will provide an overview of systems theory and how to integrate systems theory with psychoanalytic thinking about couples. They will examine the role of diagnosis in couples treatment and how to become more cognizant of various attachment styles. The concepts of first and second-order change as well as the role of the therapist in facilitating second-order change will be explored in relationship to working with couples. Other clinical issues to be considered include dealing with transference and countertransference in the context of couples therapy, boundary issues, projective identification, family of origin issues, the impact of children and various clinical interventions.
